Not sure where to start? Read through these serving opportunities and see what excites you...

SERVING WITHIN THE CHURCH

SETUP / PACK-DOWN

Join one of 6 teams that transform an empty marquee into a welcoming place of worship. Each team serves once every 3 weeks, alternating each time between setup and pack-down.

SOUND

Good sound is vital for clear and effective communication. Help set up and make sure everything that's said and sung is heard clearly; either as a sound helper or sound mixer. You will serve once every 4 weeks and we'll provide training in theory and practice of sound engineering.

WORSHIP*

Join our talented team of singers and musicians in leading our community in worship. Being part of the worship band requires an audition first, and once successful, a long term commitment to the team.

MULTIMEDIA

Multimedia in a meeting seeks to facilitate worship, teaching and communication via means of visual technology. Join a team of people who work with ProPresenter to display song words, message presentations, and video clips. Joining this team requires that you serve once every 5 weeks during both meetings. Having computer literacy is important.

SERVING THE NEXT GENERATION

KIDS ROCK*

Help our kids, between age 2.5 years and Grade 4, discover more about God during our meetings. You can do this by leading, teaching, serving on registration, leading worship, or leading a small group. Anyone wanting to serve at Kids Rock will need to be available to serve during one meeting preferably every second week.

IGNITE*

Invest in the lives of our pre-teens (Grade 5s - 7s) on Friday night and during our first Sunday morning meeting. Anyone wanting to serve will need to be available to serve once a month on Friday night, or every week/fortnight on a Sunday morning.

FREQUENCY*

Invest in the lives of our high-schoolers (Grades 8 - 12) on Friday nights, or during our second Sunday morning meeting. Anyone wanting to serve will need to be available to serve every Sunday.

BABYSITTING*

If you are part of a small group and love to spend time with children, you can serve by looking after the children of our leaders who are parents, so that they can be released to lead in different areas in the life of our church.

SERVING AS THE CHURCH INTO THE CITY

SPECIAL EVENTS

Organising successful events is a team effort. As a volunteer you'll be grouped into a specific team with whom you'll be serving for the year, on average once every 4 - 6 weeks. You'll have loads of fun as you serve and build new friendships.

MEMORIAL SERVICES TEAM

This is a team with time to spare during office hours. These people have an eye for décor and set-up, and a heart to serve families as they grieve.

REDEMPTION GROUP FACILITATION*

This is an opportunity to serve for those who are interested in assisting people with break through in certain areas of their lives. Volunteers will be trained to help facilitate groups. This vital ministry carries a commitment of one term (8 weeks).

COMMUNICATIONS TEAM

Volunteer your design, film, photography, music or writing talents to help us reach the city through creativity and excellence.

CITY-WIDE MULTIMEDIA

Join a team of people who will serve at our city wide events, mainly held at our Rondebosch venue mid-week,

using ProPresenter to display various media. Joining this team requires that you serve approximately once every 4 weeks.
